These tariff sheets are being issued February 1, 2013 to become effective on and after March 3, 2013.

The Company is adding a new Home Energy Performance (HEP) Pilot to the Company's portfolio of natural gas energy efficiency programs. The new program will be a joint program with the Company's residential electric energy efficiency program with the same name. The HEP Pilot was first approved as a joint utility approach under the Company's MEEIA tariff filing. An evaluation plan will be completed for this pilot and a description of that plan is included in the tariff.

The Company is also revising its natural gas energy efficiency program by changing one specific requirement to qualify for a ceiling insulation rebate. The current requirement is for the customer to have an existing ceiling insulation of R11 or less. The revision to this proposed tariff will increase the requirement from R11 to R19. The change to R19 will allow more customers the opportunity to participate.

The proposed tariff sheets were discussed with the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group (EEAG), which consists of the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff, Office of Public Counsel, and the Department of Natural Resources, prior to filing. The EEAG has reviewed and provided input on the final language contained in the proposed tariff sheets. The EEAG supports this proposed natural gas energy efficiency tariff as filed.
