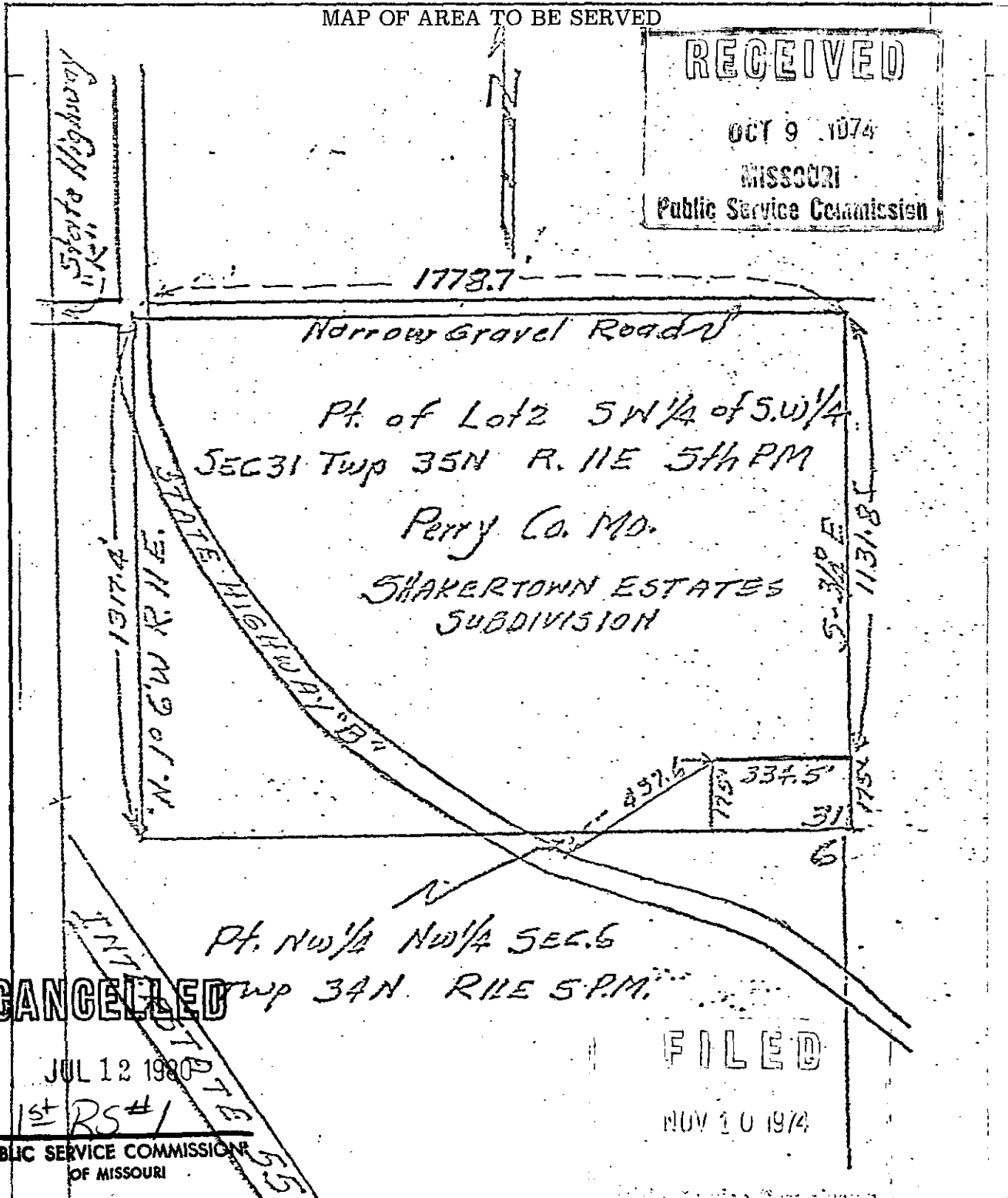

Water and Sewer Service Commission.</p> <p>(b) The "CUSTOMER" is any person, firm, corporation or governmental body receiving sewer service from Company or whose facilities are connected for utilizing such service.</p> <p>(c) A "MAIN" or "LATERAL SEWER" is a pipeline which is owned and maintained by the Company, located on public property or on private easements, and used to transport sewage wastes to a central point for disposal.</p> <p>(d) A "CUSTOMER'S SERVICE SEWER" is a pipe with appurtenances installed, owned, and maintained by the Customer, used to conduct sewage from the Customer's premise to the main.</p> <p>(e) A "SERVICE CONNECTION" is the point at which the Customer's service sewer is connected to the main through a "Y" branch or approved saddle.</p>

<b>Rule 4 - BILLS AND PAYMENT FOR SEWER SERVICE</b>	<b>OCT 9 1974</b>  <b>MISSOURI</b> Public Service Commission
<p>(a) Customers are liable for payment for all sewer service to the premises until notice has been received at the Company's office that the use of the sewer is no longer desired.</p> <p>(b) Bills for sewer services will be mailed or delivered to the Customer's last address as shown by the records of the Company, but failure to receive a bill will not relieve the Customer from the obligation to pay the same. All bills and other accounts must be paid at the office of the Company or other place designated by the Company. All bills for sewer service become delinquent after the due date stated on the bill and service may be discontinued after thirty (30) days' notice by the Company that the bill is delinquent unless the bill is paid according to said notice.</p> <p>(c) When bills are rendered for a period of less than a complete billing period due to the connection or termination of service, the billing shall be for the proportionate part of the monthly charge, or where water consumption is the basis for the charge, at the appropriate rate for water consumed, or a proportionate part of the minimum, whichever is greater. Customers terminating with less than one month's service shall pay not less than the monthly minimum.</p> <p>(d) All sewer Customers whose sewer service charges are determined on the basis of water use who use in excess of 30,000 gallons of water per month, and can show to the satisfaction of the Company that a portion of the water as measured by the water meter or meters does not and cannot enter the sanitary sewerage system, the Company may determine in such manner and by such method as it may deem practicable the percentage of metered water entering the sanitary sewerage system. Rule 5 - DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE

(a) The Company reserves the right upon the giving of <sup>not less than thirty</sup> (30) days written notice to the customer, to discontinue service for non-payment of sewer bills or for violation of or refusal to comply with these rules and regulations, such written notice to be sent by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested and a copy of said notice to be forwarded to the Public Service Commission. The notice shall state the violation and that service may be discontinued at any time after the date specified in such notice, provided satisfactory arrangements for continuance of service have not been made.

(b) Service may be discontinued without notice in the event that a customer shall cause to be discharged materials which are detrimental to the public health and safety, or which may cause damage to the sewer system. In the event that the discontinuance of service shall be for the causes herein stated the customer and the Public Service Commission shall be notified of such discontinuance immediately with a statement giving the reason for such discontinuance.

(c) In areas where S. K. & Water and Sewer Co. provides water service, the Company reserves the right to request the water supply to be shut off in lieu of disconnecting Customer's service sewer. When the Company disconnects and plugs the Customer's service sewer at the point of connection to the Company's main, the total cost of disconnection and re-establishment of service shall be at the Customer's expense.

(d) Discontinuance of sewage service to a premise for any reason shall not prevent the Company from pursuing any lawful remedy by action at law or otherwise for the collection of moneys due from the Customer.

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Rule 7 - SERVICE CONNECTION AND TAPS

(a) The Company will locate the point to which service connection will be made and Customer will furnish a "Y" branch or approved saddle at the main or lateral sewer which shall be located in the public street or right-of-way. All taps are to be made by licensed plumbers, subject to inspection and approval by the Company. Application, accompanied by a \$100.00 sewer entrance fee, as provided in Rate Schedule No. S-1, must be filed in writing 24 hours in advance stating the street, the house number, name of applicant, name of property owner, and time at which tap is to be made. The Company will not be required to supply sewer service until each such tap has been inspected and approved by it. Customer will be liable for any damages to Company sewer mains resulting from such work.

(b) The building service sewer connection from the main or lateral sewer to the Customer's building shall be installed by and at the expense of the Customer. A service sewer connection shall not be used to supply more than a single property without the consent of the Company.

(c) Customer service sewer will not be extended along public streets or roadways or through property of others in connecting with sewer mains, unless approved by the Company.

(d) Any change in the location of an existing service connection requested by the Customer shall be made at his expense.

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Rule 8 - INSIDE PIPING AND CUSTOMER SERVICE SEWERS

MISSOURI

(a) The Customer will provide the Customer's service sewer at his expense and risk. As a condition of service, inside piping and building sewer construction must meet all of the requirements of the latest editions of the Plumbing Rules and Regulations of the Administrative Building Council, Volume III, at the time of connection to the system. The Company shall deny service where footing drains, downspouts, or other sources of surface water are permitted to enter the system through either the inside piping or through the building sewer.

(b) A separate and independent Customer service sewer shall be required for every building; except where one building stands at the rear of another on an interior lot and no private sewer is available or can be constructed to the rear building through an adjoining alley, court, yard, or driveway, the Customer's service sewer from the front building may be extended to the rear building and the whole considered as one Customer's service sewer.

(c) Old Customer service sewers may be used in connection with new buildings only when they are found on examination and test to meet all requirements of the Company.

(d) The Customer's service sewer shall be cast iron soil pipe, ASTM specification or equal; vitrified clay sewer pipe, ASTM specification or equal; or other suitable material approved by the Company. Joints shall be tight and waterproof. Any part of the Customer's service sewer that is located within ten feet of a water service pipe shall be constructed of cast iron soil pipe. Cast iron pipes may be required where the Customer's service sewer is exposed to damage by tree roots. If installed in filled or unstable ground, the Customer's service sewer shall be of cast iron soil pipe, except that non-metallic material may be accepted if laid on a suitable concrete bed or cradle as approved by the said Company.

The slope of such four (4) inch pipe shall not be less than one-eighth (1/8) inch per foot.</p> <p>(f) Whenever possible the Customer's service sewer shall be brought to the building at an elevation below the basement floor. No building sewer shall be laid parallel to or within three (3) feet of any bearing wall. The depth shall be sufficient to afford protection from frost. The Customer's service sewer shall be laid at a uniform grade and in straight alignment insofar as possible. Changes in direction shall be made only with properly curved pipes and fittings.</p> <p>(g) In all buildings in which any building drain is too low to permit gravity flow to the Company's main, sanitary sewage carried by such drains shall be lifted by approved artificial means and discharged to the building sewer. No water operated sewage ejector shall be used.</p> <p>(h) All excavations required for the installation of a Customer's service sewer shall be open trench work unless otherwise approved by the Company. Pipe laying and backfill shall be performed in accordance with ASTM specifications, except that no backfill shall be placed until the work has been inspected by the Company. (i) The connection of the Customer's service sewer into the main shall be made at the "Y" branch, if such branch is available at a suitable location. If the Company's main is twelve (12) inches in diameter or less and no properly located "Y" branch in the Company's main at the location specified by the Company, a "Y" branch must be installed. Where the Company's main is greater than twelve (12) inches in diameter, and no properly located "Y" branch is available, a neat hole may be cut in the Company's main and an approved saddle installed to receive the Customer's service sewer. The invert of the Customer's service sewer at the point of connection shall be at the same or at a higher elevation than the invert of the Company's main. A smooth neat joint shall be made, and the connection made secure and water tight by encasement in concrete.

(j) It is understood that all facilities above described are to be constructed and maintained by the applicant subject to the approval of any authorized inspector, and in accordance with the Rules and information of the Company in force at that time.

Rule 10 - CHARGES

(a) Service Charges;

1. An application for a service connection (turn-on), or disconnection (turn-off) of an existing service will be made during the Company's regular business hours.

2. In the event service to any Customer has been discontinued for any reason set forth in Rule 5, and a reconnect charge is provided for, such charge shall be based on cost thereby incurred by the Company, but not less than \$2.00 during regular business hours and \$5.00 at all other times.

3. Company personnel will not work upon sewer piping or facilities not owned by the Company.

4. The service charges cited in the various sections of this Rule are "net" and do not include any applicable Municipal, State or Federal taxes computed on the Company's collections of such charges. Any such taxes will be added in collection or billing service charges, as appropriate.

(b) Customer Deposit:

The Company shall have the right at any time to require the Customer to make a reasonable deposit, in amount not to exceed the estimated bill for one billing period plus thirty (30) days, in advance, to secure the prompt payment of bills. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%), payable upon return of the deposit, will be paid for the time such deposit was held by the Company unless such period of time be less than six (6) months. Such deposits shall be refunded at the termination of service after all charges that may be due and payable by the Customer have been paid.

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Rule 11 - EXTENSION OF FACILITIES

The Company will extend its collection system Public Service Commission free of charge to the Customer. Any additional extension requested by a Customer will be at the expense of said Customer.

The Customer shall deposit with the Company the amount of the cost of said extension. During the period of 5 years from and after the date of such extension paid for by the Customer, the Customer shall receive a refund of the cost as follows:

(a) 50% of the cost of construction of each 100 feet paid for by the Customer for each connection;

(b) 50% of the unpaid total cost of construction to the Customer in the event that the Company shall further extend said sewer collection system at the request of other parties;

(c) No costs shall be recovered after a period of 5 years has elapsed from the date construction shall have commenced on the extension requested by the Customer.
