ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATES AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFFS

Issue Date: March 23, 2011

Effective Date: April 2, 2011

On January 4, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting T-Netix, Inc. ("T-Netix") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-98-269, the Commission granted T-Netix a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that T-Netix has reported no jurisdictional revenue in annual reports for the years 2008 and 2009. Staff notes that it is not in the public interest to allow telecommunication companies to retain their certificates of service authority if they have not conducted business in Missouri for over a year. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services, and the company's accompanying tariff.

On February 17, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than

February 28, 2011. On February 22, 2011, the Company filed a letter with the Commission indicating they wished to cancel the certificate of service authority and tariff for T-Netix, Inc. and also requested the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority and tariff for T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc. (“T-Netix Telecom”).

On February 24, 2011, Staff filed an amended motion to include the cancellation request for T-Netix Telecom. In File Number TO-2001-0407, the Commission granted T-Netix Telecom a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

On February 24, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than March 7, 2011. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s amended motion, the Commission finds that the certificates of service authority and accompanying tariffs granted to T-Netix, Inc. and T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to T-Netix, Inc., in File Number TA-98-269, is canceled.
2. T-Netix, Inc.'s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc., in File Number TO-2001-0407, is canceled.
4. T-Netix Telecommunications Services, Inc.'s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
5. This order shall become effective on April 2, 2011.
6. This case may be closed on April 3, 2011.
