ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATES AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFFS

Issue Date: June 21, 2005

Effective Date: July 1, 2005

On June 7, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificates of Service Authority and Associated Tariffs. Staff requested that the Commission cancel Ameritel Missouri, Inc.'s interexchange and basic local exchange certificates of service authority. The Commission granted those certificates to Ameritel in Case No. LA-2004-0047.

Staff stated that Ameritel is no longer entitled to its certificates because the Missouri Secretary of State administratively dissolved Ameritel in 2004. Staff further stated that Ameritel evidently does not provide services in Missouri, that Ameritel does not have a valid address, and that Ameritel has no authority to conduct business in Missouri.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) gives parties 10 days to respond to pleadings. Ameritel failed to respond within 10 days.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission

has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel Ameritel's certificates of service authority and accompanying tariffs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificates of Service Authority and Associated Tariffs is granted.
2. That the basic local exchange telecommunications certificate of service authority, non-switched local exchange telecommunications certificate of service authority, and the interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority granted to Ameritel Missouri, Inc., in Case No. LA-2004-0047, are canceled.
3. That the accompanying tariffs, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, P.S.C. Mo. No. 2, and P.S.C. Mo. No. 3, are canceled.
4. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
5. That this case may be closed on July 2, 2005.
