RE: Request Commission Approval of Revised Tariff Sheet No. 46 Solar Photovoltaic Rebate Program

Dear Secretary:

Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L" or "Company") seeks approval from the Missouri Public Service Commission of the enclosed revision to the Solar Photovoltaic Rebate Program tariff (Program).

Significant rebates have been paid out under the Program and consistent with §393.1030, the Company has determined the maximum average retail rate increase provided for in 4 CSR 240-20.100 will be reached in this calendar year. Accordingly, the Company is filing to suspend the Program for the remainder of this calendar year and is requesting this tariff be made effective in 60 days, on November 9, 2013. The Company intends to cease paying rebates on that date.

The Company will continue to accept applications for Net Metering and Solar Rebates, but rebates for Solar Electric Systems will not be available until a subsequent calendar year. Rebates earned will be paid in order, based on the operational date of the Solar Electric System.
