**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT  
OF TARIFF FILING**

Primus Telecommunications, Inc. (“PTI”) and Least Cost Routing, Inc. (“LCR,” together “Applicants”), through undersigned counsel and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), hereby request expedited approval from the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) of the attached Tariff Filing (designated **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by reference) submitted this date by Primus, in order to permit them to effectuate the proposed transaction which is the subject of this proceeding no later than December 31, 2007.

1. As fully set forth in the Cover Letter of Exhibit 1, Primus is filing the attached Adoption Notice and Revised Title Page to the existing tariff of Least Cost Routing, Inc., establishing Primus’ Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 3 for the provision of service to those customers that were served by Least Cost Routing, Inc. at the time the subject internal reorganization is approved by this Commission.

2. While the attached tariff sheets reflect a 30-day effective date (Issued date of December 12, 2007 and an Effective date of January 11, 2007), Applicants are filing this Motion for Expedited Treatment, requesting that the Commission approve such tariffs to be effective on

or before December 31, 2007, to coincide with the internal reorganization approval as requested in this matter.

3. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), Applicants respectfully seek expedited treatment and approval of said Tariff Filing and request that the Commission act in approving and allowing said tariff sheets to be effective on or before December 31, 2007, in order to permit the parties to effectuate the internal reorganization as requested herein. Such action will benefit the applicants and their customers and there will be no negative effect on the applicants' customers or the general public if the commission acts by said date. This pleading was filed as soon as it could have been.

WHEREFORE, Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve the subject tariffs to be effective on or before December 31, 2007.
