Improved Mobile Telephone Service, hereafter referred to as IMTS, allows a mobile subscriber to originate and receive calls to or from other IMTS mobile stations, fixed mobile stations, or land-line telephone through the local channel, provided he is within range of the tower and base station (approximately 25 miles radius) which is located near and operates through the Pilot Grove, Missouri telephone exchange.
2. IMTS also allows a mobile subscriber to "roam" into range and receive service from a "foreign base station" which is served by another company, provided his mobile set is equipped with the proper channel equipment for compatibility with the foreign base station.
3. The local channel service entitles the mobile subscriber to the same service as a land-line subscriber in the Pilot Grove, Missouri exchange.
4. The Telephone Company is not obligated to furnish IMTS service when facilities are not available

B. IMTS - COMPANY OWNED EQUIPMENT

1. Preferrably all equipment for providing IMTS is furnished and owned by the Telephone Company
2. All installation and maintenance work is performed by Telephone Company personnel or by licensed contractors qualified to perform the necessary work. When unusual maintenance work results from negligence of the subscriber, the Telephone Company will bill him actual cost of labor, materials, and miscellaneous charges necessary to restore the unit to a serviceable condition. It is the responsibility of the customer to deliver his vehicle to where the equipment is to be serviced.

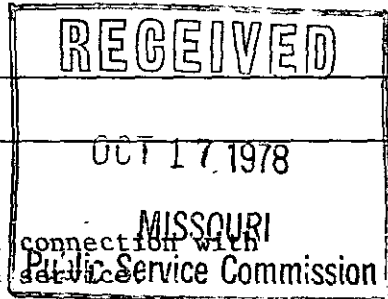

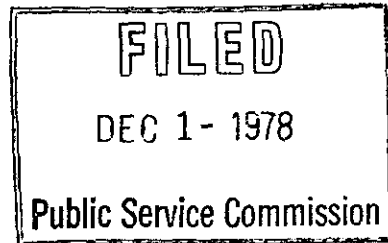
