The State of Missouri, at the relation of William L. Webster, Attorney General, upon information of John A. Pelzer, Commissioner, Office of Administration, submits this application to intervene in the above-captioned matter, and in support thereof states:

- William L. Webster is the duly elected Attorney General of the State of Missouri and, as such, is authorized by law to appear and interplead on behalf of the State of Missouri in any proceeding or tribunal in which the state's interests may be involved.
- The Office of Administration is the department within the state government of Missouri which is responsible for contracting for the provision of steam service to state-owned premises located in Kansas City, Missouri.
