2.3 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

.1 Liability of the Carrier

Carrier is not liable for any act, omission or negligence of any local exchange carrier or other provider whose facilities are used in furnishing any portion of the service received by Customer. Under no circumstances whatever shall Carrier or its officers, agents, or employees be liable for indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages.
