(1) Any license, occupational, franchise tax or similar charge levied by municipal or taxing authority is to be added to the above rates and shown as a separate item on the customer's bill.		
(2) <u>Demarcation Point</u> – The point of connection, provided and maintained by the telephone utility to which the station wiring becomes dedicated to an individual customer's use. For an individual customer dwelling, this point of connection will generally be the modular jack incorporated into the customer side of the Network Interface Device (NID). The drop wire and the network protector will continue to be provided by, and remain the property of, the Telephone Company. The demarcation point is usually the point at which the Telephone Company wiring connects with the customer's wiring.
