Enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission are the revised tariff sheets, P.S.C. MO. No. 7 First Revised Sheet No. R-30.17 along with sheet, P.S.C MO. No 7 First Revised Sheet No. R-30.18 and P.S.C MO. No. 8 First Revised Sheet No. R-30.17 along with sheet, P.S.C. MO. No. 8 First Revised Sheet No. R-30.18 in regards to the Eastern and Western Missouri operating divisions of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire (the "Company"). These revised tariff sheets, have an issue date of February 5, 2020, and an effective date of March 6, 2020, reflected by the Company's tariff.

In order to better serve our low-income customers that reside in our Spire Missouri West service territory, we are submitting these revised tariffs for your approval. With your approval, it will allow Spire to continue co-delivery efforts with Evergy Missouri West and Evergy Missouri Metro which was recently approved to start their MEEIA Cycle 3 programs on January 1, 2020. Both companies are working with ICF as the 3<sup>rd</sup> party administrator for continued synergies for our shared customers. The primary changes to the tariffs are company named related in regards to KCP&L being updated to Evergy and the qualifications for customer made in line with the tariff language approved for Evergy. Spire also drafted language to help customers utilize incentive funding by providing up to 100% of the installed measure cost in line with the Ameren Missouri Gas Tariff language.

No additional funds are being requested outside of the funding we already have budgeted with our EEC Portfolio to operate this revision to the Company's tariff. Spire will work with Evergy to provide EM&V details upon completion of the program.
