 - A. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (Company) will discontinue service from specific EAS routes between exchanges as a result of a survey as set forth following:
 - 1. Company has received a petition or petitions representing at least 20 percent of the customers from one of the affected exchanges or at least 10 percent of the customers in each of the affected exchanges, requesting that the Company conduct a survey to determine whether EAS should be discontinued.
