## 30.1 EXCHANGE ACCESS CHARGE

### 30.1.1 General

- A. Embedded Complex Inside Wire for purposes of this Tariff is that wire that was provided by the Telephone Company, associated with Complex Systems and leased in place prior to January 1, 1984. Such wire included associated connectors, jacks and miscellaneous materials located within a customer's premises and on the customer's side of the Telephone Company-provided Network Interface.(1)
