## MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission open a case and cancel the certificate of service authority it granted to Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services, as well as the company's tariff. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. The Commission granted Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, limited to exchanges served by certain large incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies, in Case No. TA-98-552 in October 1998. The company's current tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 3, was subsequently approved.
- 2. Phone-Link, Inc. is a North Carolina corporation and is reflected by the Missouri Secretary of State's office as being in good standing.
- 3. The Commission has received a letter from counsel for Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI indicating that the company "has not marketed its services and accordingly has no customers to notify of its decision to withdraw its certificate." The company seeks immediate cancellation of its certificate. See Appendix A.
- 4. Staff is not aware that Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI is still providing telecommunications services to any Missouri customers. In Case No. TA-98-552, the

Commission granted authority for Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to provide service to customers in areas served by "SWBT, GTE Midwest Incorporated (GTE), and Sprint Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Sprint (Sprint)." Subsequently, Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI entered into interconnection agreements only with SBC Missouri, Inc. (see Case No. TO-99-130 and TO-2000-636). In Case No. TO-2005-0336, in its initial *Petition* seeking arbitration in that matter, SBC Missouri, Inc. listed Business Telecom, Inc. as one of the CLECs that, when contacted by SBC Missouri to negotiate a successor interconnection agreement, informed SBC Missouri that they planned to discontinue service and terminate the interconnection agreement.

- 5. No customers have contacted the Commission to make complaints about Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI since the commencement of the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System.
- 6. Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI has paid all assessments and submitted all annual reports to date.
- 7. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2005), which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

- 8. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).
- 9. This pleading will be served via certified mail upon the address provided most recently by Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to the Commission (which is identical with that provided to the Missouri Secretary of State), as well as upon its Missouri registered agent.

10. Thus, the Commission has the authority to cancel the certificate of service

authority it granted to Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to provide basic local exchange

telecommunications services in Case No. TA-98-552, as well as the company's tariff, P.S.C.

MO. No. 3. Such an action is supported because the company has no Missouri customers, nor

does it intend to provide service in the future in Missouri, and because its representative has

requested cancellation.

11. Finally, Staff notes that Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI holds a certificate to

provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services under Case No. TA-93-102, but

that certificate is unaffected by this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests that the Commission grant Staff's Motion and cancel

the certificate of service authority it granted to Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI to provide

basic local exchange telecommunications services in Case No. TA-98-552 as well as the

company's tariff, P.S.C. MO. No. 3.
