SUPPLY OF SERVICE

Rule 1.

Rule 4.

A cash deposit not to exceed estimated revenue for one (1) billing period plus thirty (30) days may be required from meter consumers to guarantee the payment of water bills and cost of repairs as set forth in Rule 18. Interest at the rate of six percent (6%) per annum, upon the return of any deposit covering the time of the deposit, shall be paid by the Company to the Consumer upon every cash deposit so required; provided said cash deposit remains with the Company for a period of at least six months.

Rule 5.

Not applicable.

CONSUMER'S INSTALLATIONRule 6.

Consumers will not be permitted to use water for purposes other than those stated in the application or agreement, nor will they be allowed to supply water in any way to other persons without permit from the Company, or permit others to use their hose or attachments or leave them exposed to use by others.

Rule 7.

Consumers will be required to prevent the waste of water, and keep all plumbing fixtures in good condition at their own expense and all waterways closed when not in use.

Rule 8.

No physical connection will be allowed between a service line from the mains of the Company and any pipe or tank which shall contain water of polluted or otherwise questionable character, or which is not a water supply approved by the State Board of Health of Missouri. Should such a cross-connection be found, the Company will discontinue service to the Consumer in question, after a 24-hour notice, unless all physical connections between the two water supplies have been severed.

SERVICE CONNECTION AND TAPSRule 9.

All taps are to be made by plumbers approved by Company. Application, accompanied by a \$10.00 tapping and inspection fee, must be filed in writing 24 hours in advance stating the street, the house number, name of applicant, name of property owner, size of service pipe and time at which tap is to be made. The Company will not be required to supply water service until each such tap has been inspected and approved by it. Customer will be liable for any damages to Company water mains resulting from such work.

Rule 10.

The service line from the main to the meter shall be type K copper, or other equivalent material approved by the Company, and not less than 3/4" in diameter. For service lines 2-1/2" and larger in diameter, cast iron pipes and fittings conforming to applicable specification may be used. The service line must be laid out at right angles to the main and at right angles to the face of the building at the point where the service line enters the face of the building. At the property line or curblin necessary connections as specified by the Company shall be provided by the Customer for installation of a meter by the Company. If the service line

Rule 11.

Water services must be laid in trenches separate from sewer line trenches. The earth between the separate trenches shall not be less in width than the depth of the water service line below the finished grade. A shelf cut into the side of a sewer drain trench is a separate trench within the meaning and requirements of this rule.

Rule 12.

The excavation for tapping a main must be free of mud and water and must be of sufficient size to allow the tapper to attach and operate the tapping machine.

Rule 13.

Consumers will not be permitted to extend service lines along public or private streets, or roadways, or through property of others in order to obtain connection to a water main.

Rule 14.

A brass stop and waste cock with lever handle, easily accessible to occupants, shall be placed in the service pipe inside the building at the point of entrance, and at such point that the water may be drained out of the pipes in the building.

Rule 15.

Service pipes must be installed at least 3-1/2 feet below surface of the ground and run to the center line of the main if copper pipe or lead pipe fitted with solder nipple is used.

Rule 16.

All service pipes, valves, stop cocks, stop and waste cocks, stop boxes, curb and meter boxes which are the property of the Consumer, are to be kept in repair by the Consumer.

Rule 17.

Meters will be installed by the Company, and each meter will be and remain the sole property of the Company.

Rule 18.

Consumers must take necessary precaution to prevent pipes and meters from freezing in cold weather. The Company will make all ordinary repairs to meters, but in case meters are damaged through freezing, hot water backing up into meter, or other neglect of the Consumer, the cost of repairs will be assessed against the Consumer and payment for such repairs will be enforced the same as bills for water service.

Rule 19.

No person except a duly authorized employee of the Company or other person duly authorized by the Company shall set, change, remove or interfere with or make any connection to the Company's meter or appurtenances thereto.

ADJUSTMENT OF METER ERRORRule 20.

Consumer shall accept as standard of measurement the meter installed by the Company. Should the meter become defective or fail to register correctly, the quantity of water used shall be determined by a test of the meter, by the amount of water used during a corresponding period the preceding year, or by an estimate based on the average amount of water used during the preceding twelve months applied to the period during which the meter is shown to have become defective or inaccurate.

Rule 21.

The Company, at its expense, will make periodic tests and inspections of its meters in order to maintain them at a high standard of accuracy. The Company will make a test of the accuracy of any water meter, free of charge, upon request of a consumer, provided that the meter has not been tested within twelve months previous to such request.

MAINTENANCE AND USE OF SERVICERule 22.

The Company will not be liable for any failure to furnish water provided such failure is due to causes beyond its control. Reasonable efforts will be made to prevent interruptions of service and when such interruptions occur, service will be re-established with the shortest possible delay.

Rule 23.

The Manager of the Company is authorized to limit by special rules and orders, any use of water for the sprinkling of fields, gardens, orchards, lawns, parks, club grounds, streets, avenues or roads, or any unusual, unnecessary or wasteful use of water, and the Manager may prohibit and prevent the sprinkling of streets, avenues and roads, and other public places through the private service pipes or connections supplying the premises of water consumers. During the time of a fire, however, all such uses of water may be absolutely forbidden.

Rule 24.

It is forbidden for Consumers to open any large valves or other openings and thereby to fill any tank, basin, reservoir, swimming pool or other large receptacle, except after first making arrangements with the Manager of the Company for filling the same and then observing and conforming to the instructions of the Manager about the hours, the size of pipes or hose, and other proper details as to the manner of filling any such tanks, receptacles, etc.

Rule 25.

The inspectors or other authorized agents of the Company shall have access to the premises at all reasonable hours to read meters, make repairs, and see if the rules are observed.

Rule 26.

Plumbers are not allowed to turn water off or on at a corporation cock to any service pipe except to make repairs and test their work after which they will leave the cock as they found it. Other persons not connected with the Company are strictly forbidden to turn the water on or off at the corporation or stop cock. Water may be turned on to any premises only by an employee of the Company.

PAYMENT RULESRule 27.

Payments are to be made monthly. Rates are quoted for quantities used in gallons per month.

Rule 28.

Each meter installed on a separate service line shall be billed as a separate consumer, unless such additional meter installation is required by the Company for convenience of measuring the amount of water taken.

EXTENSION OF COMPANY MAINSRule 34.

## (a) Extension.

1. The Company will, upon written request by Customer or subdivider, extend its water mains along public highways, streets or alleys where grades have been established or within easements acceptable to the Company upon the Customer paying, in advance, the total cost of the mains, and other necessary appurtenances. The cost shall include all labor and materials, supervision, engineering, and other costs prescribed by the Uniform System of Accounts.

2. If the Company wishes facilities installed larger in size than required by Customer, in accordance with sound engineering practices, the additional cost of the larger facilities shall be borne by the Company.

3. Extensions made under this rule shall be and remain the property of the Company. The Company reserves the right to extend further the main and connecting mains on intersecting streets without additional payments by the Customer.

## (b) Refund.

1. No refunds will be made for extensions installed hereunder when the extension is solely within an existing platted subdivision.
