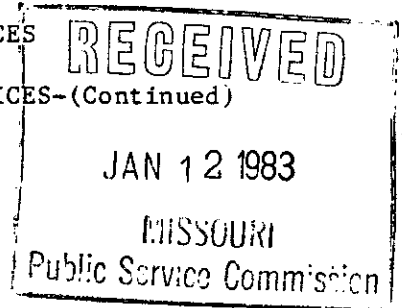

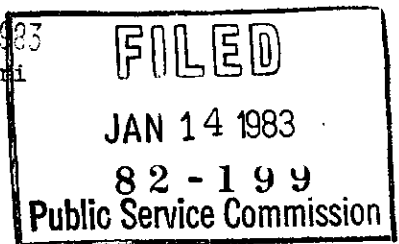

The DSC, located on the customer's premises, provides polling, terminal switching, protocol conversion and speed conversion in a private line environment for inquiry/response applications.

The transmissions between the DSC and the polled terminals originate as digital, serial, 1200 bit per second (bps), asynchronous signals. The built-in Frequency Shift Key (FSK) modem at the DSC converts the signals to analog for transmission over data channels to the terminals. When Transaction III terminals are used, their built-in modems convert the signals back to digital use by terminals.

The transmissions between the DSC and the host computer originate as digital, serial, 2400 bps, synchronous signals. Type 2024A-L1/2 or equivalent data sets at the DSC convert the signal to analog for transmission to the host computer over Type 313 data channels as found in Section 2 of this Tariff. Type 2024A-L1/2 or equivalent data sets at the host location convert the signals back to the digital for communication with the computer.

The service includes the provision of technical materials describing the functions and capabilities of the DSC. It also includes Company assistance in developing a DSC System and augmenting understanding of the materials sufficiently that the customer's computer personnel can program the host computer to take advantage of the DSC's functional capability. Assistance is to be provided to the customer in connection with the initial set up of a DSC System and during the first six months of operation. The customer is expected to provide training and assistance to his secondary and replacement employees.

At the customer's request, subsequent Company assistance requiring other than telephone consultation, will be provided at charges based on estimated costs, including travel and lodging.
