c. Conforming Answering Device

A customer-provided device which answers incoming calls; transmits a prerecorded voice message or appropriate audible signal to the calling party; records a voice message from the calling party if so designed and arranged; and automatically disconnects from the line in a prearranged manner on completion of the last of the functions for which it was designed and arranged as described in this paragraph. The conforming answering device may include remote interrogation and/or device function control. A conforming answering device must incorporate an authorized protective connecting module and must bear a valid conformance number.

d. Connection of a Conforming Answering Device

A conforming answering device may be connected to facilities furnished by the Telephone Company in accordance with (1) through (6) following.

(1) The customer shall notify the Telephone Company of his intention to connect a conforming answering device. Such notification shall include the location at which the conforming answering device is to be used as well as the conformance number of the conforming answering device.

(2) The conforming answering device shall only be connected by means of a jack or jack arrangement provided by the Telephone Company.

The conforming answering device shall not be used to transmit or receive data signals.

- B. Discontinuance of WATS and associated equipment at one premises and their installation at another premises, all within the same exchange, is considered as an outside move and is subject to regular installation charges and non-recurring charges that may be applicable.
- C. Unless specifically excepted, installation charges quoted in this section do not apply to reconnections of in-place miscellaneous equipment.
- D. Certain items of supplemental equipment require the use of commercial power. The rates quoted contemplate the use of standard equipment designed to operate on 110 volts, 60 cycle A-C power. Where required, the customer shall furnish, install and maintain the commercial power and convenience outlets to operate the equipment.
- E. When the customer requests a service arrangement which can be furnished under the terms of the WATS offering but which cannot be provided with regularly offered equipment, services, and arrangements; modifications of standard equipment, specially designed equipment, or special services and arrangements will be furnished. They will be provided under the special assemblies of equipment procedure. These will not be furnished if detrimental to the general service.
