Dear Secretary Woodruff:

On behalf of Spire Missouri Inc. (the "Company"), enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission are the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program tariff sheets, P.S.C. MO. No. 7, First Revised, Sheet No. R-31.4 of the eastern Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire East") and P.S.C. MO. No. 8, First Revised, Sheet No. R-31.4 of the western Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri and P.S.C. MO. No. 8, First Revised, Sheet No. R-31.4 of the western Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri operating division of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire ("Spire West"). These tariff sheets, have an issue date of March 17, 2021 and an effective date of April 16, 2021.

These tariffs support the COVID-19 Residential Assistance Program which is available to eligible residential customers in the service territories of Spire Missouri East and Spire Missouri West to assist them in paying their natural gas bills during the COVID-19 pandemic. Currently the program ends under the tariff on March 31, 2021. Given the ongoing financial crisis facing many of the Company's residential customers, the Company is filing to revise its tariff to extend the program for an additional two months, from March 31, 2021 to May 30, 2021, and has proposed to implement a self-declaration as an additional means for customers to show program eligibility. These tariff changes will further expand the Program's outreach to the benefit of residential customers who have lost their job, been furloughed, or can show a loss of income since March of 2020.

As a separate filing is a Motion for Expedited Treatment requesting that these tariffs become effective on March 31, 2021, instead of April 16, 2021, so that our qualified residential customers can continue to have access to energy assistance funding on a timely basis. Absent expedited treatment, the program administration would be suspended from April 1 until the effective date of the tariffs.
