# ORDER REGARDING DEMAND SIDE INVESTMENT MECHANISM **RIDER RATE ADJUSTMENT**

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Issue Date: January 18, 2017

Effective Date: February 1, 2017

On December 1, 2016, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L" or "Company") submitted a tariff sheet with a February 1, 2017 effective date that adjusts the rate of the Company's Demand Side Investment Mechanism ("DSIM") rider under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA"). The Commission issued notice of the filing, set an intervention deadline, and directed the Commission's Staff to submit a recommendation. No applications to intervene were received.

Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-20.093(4) and 4 CSR 240-3.163(8) require KCP&L to make semi-annual adjustments to its DSIM rates to reflect the amount of revenue that has been over/under collected. The MEEIA mechanism rate is based on six months of projected costs (January 2017 through June 2017) and incentives with reconciliations from actual prior periods, including any Commission-ordered adjustments with interest. The DSIM rate adjustment submitted by KCP&L begins to incorporate the performance incentive for the Company's MEEIA Cycle 1. The tariff sheet increases the current residential DSIM rate from \$0.00332 per kWh to \$0.00391

per kWh. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWh, this will increase the line item on a monthly bill by \$0.59 per month. For non-residential customers, the current DSIM rate of \$0.01010 decreases to \$0.00433. For a non-residential customer, this will result in a monthly decrease of \$5.77 for every 1,000 kWh used.

Staff filed a recommendation to approve the tariff sheet. Staff noted that the Company's DSIM filing includes recognition of the earned performance incentive award after evaluation, measurement, and verification of KCP&L's MEEIA program performance in Cycle 1. No responses to Staff's recommendation were received. Finding the filing to be reasonable, the Commission will approve the tariff sheet adjustment to KCP&L's DSIM rate.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's tariff filing, assigned Tariff Tracking No. JE-2017-0111, is approved. The tariff sheet approved is:
