## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Issue Date: June 13, 2006

Effective Date: June 23, 2006

This order cancels the certificate of convenience and necessity and accompanying tariff of Ozark Water and Wastewater Management Company, Inc.

On February 17, 2004, the Commission issued an order granting Ozark Water authority to transfer its assets to English Village Not-for-Profit Sewer Corporation. That order also authorized Ozark Water to cease operations following the transfer of its assets. The order did not, however, specifically cancel Ozark Water's certificate of convenience and necessity or its tariff.

On June 1, 2006, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion indicating that the sale of Ozark Water's assets had closed by February 1, 2005, and that that Ozark Water is no longer providing water or sewer service. Staff now asks the Commission to take the final step and cancel Ozark Water's certificate and tariff. Ozark Water has not responded to Staff's motion.

Based on Staff's uncontested motion, the Commission finds that Ozark Water's certificate of convenience and necessity and accompanying tariff should be canceled.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The certificate of convenience and necessity previously granted to Ozark Water and Wastewater Management Company, Inc., is canceled.
  - 2. Ozark Water and Wastewater Management Company, Inc.'s tariff, P.S.C. MO.

No. 1, is canceled.

- 3. This order shall become effective on June 23, 2006.
- 4. This case may be closed on June 24, 2006.
