- I. General Regulations
 - A. Schedules of monthly rates quoted herein apply only in connection with standard systems and equipment owned by the telephone Company.
 - B. All operating at customers' premises is performed at the expense of the customer, and must conform to whatever rules and regulations the Company may consider necessary to maintain a proper standard of service.




