ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

Issue Date: December 14, 2022

Effective Date: December 23, 2022

On December 8, 2022,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Granting Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* (Order) granting Seges Utility Company, LLC (Seges Utility Co.) the certificates of convenience and necessity (CCNs) to operate an existing regulated water and sewer system in Seges Mobile Home Park, located in Callaway County, Missouri. On November 23, prior to the Order being issued, Seges Utility Co. filed tariff sheets assigned Tracking Nos. YW-2023-0093 and YS-2023-0094. Seges Utility Co. stated it is seeking to have the new tariff sheets in effect at the time of closing on the assets.

These tariff sheets are designed to adopt the existing water and sewer tariffs of 188 North Summit, LLC, consistent with the recommendation to approve the CCNs with conditions filed by the Staff of the Commission (Staff) on November 1. On November 28, Seges Utility Co. filed a substitute tariff sheet No. 3 for Tracking No.

YS-2023-0094 to correct a typographical error. All tariff sheets have proposed effective dates of December 23.

On December 2, 2022, Staff filed an expedited recommendation affirming that the tariff sheets comply with Staff's November 1 recommendation to approve the CCNs with conditions the Commission subsequently adopted in its Order. Upon reviewing the pleadings, the Commission finds Seges Utility Co.'s proposed tariff sheets, as substituted on November 28, comply with the Commission's Order and will approve them. To accommodate the chosen tariff effective date, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

The Commission notes that its Order has an effective date of January 7, 2023, which is after the requested effective date of the compliance tariffs. Given the needs of the customers, the sale of the subject mobile home park, and the lack of objections to approving the Application or compliance tariffs, the Commission finds it reasonable on its own motion to change the effective date of its *Order Granting Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* to December 23, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The proposed tariff sheets filed on November 23, and assigned Tracking Nos. YW-2023-0093 and YS-2023-0094, as substituted on November 28, are approved.
2. This order shall be effective on December 23.
3. The effective date of the Commission's *Order Granting Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity*, issued December 8, is changed from the original effective date of January 7, 2023, to a new effective date of December 23, 2022.
