**ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On May 7, 2013, Charles Harter filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. On August 26, 2013, the parties jointly filed a proposed procedural schedule. The Commission adopted the proposed procedural schedule and set an evidentiary hearing in Chesterfield, Missouri. The hearing was set in the county where the utility service was rendered in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070(15)(E) and as a convenience to Mr. Harter. On August 28, 2013, Mr. Harter notified the Commission that he prefers the hearing to be held in Jefferson City, Missouri. The Commission will amend the procedural schedule to move the location of the hearing to Jefferson City, Missouri.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The location of the evidentiary hearing scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on September 19, 2013 in Chesterfield, Missouri will be changed to Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, at the same time and date.

2. All other provisions of the procedural schedule shall remain in effect.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
