## NOTICE OF RECOMMENDED REPORT AND ORDER

Once the Commission approves this recommended report and order, or issues its own report and order, any interested person may ask the Commission to consider the report and order again by filing an application for rehearing with the Commission. An application for rehearing is required for any matter on which anyone seeks to appeal the report and order.

If the Commission denies the application for rehearing, or grants the rehearing but maintains the report and order, any interested person may seek judicial review by filing an appeal in the Missouri Court of Appeals.
