**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF IN COMPLIANCE
WITH COMMISSION ORDER**

On September 11, 2019, the Commission issued an order granting Timber Creek Sewer Company (Timber Creek) a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide sewer service in Clay County, Missouri, as an expansion of its existing certificated area. Timber Creek filed compliance Tariff No. YS-2020-0057 pursuant to the Commission's order. The tariff has an effective date of November 13, 2019.

On October 28, 2019, Staff filed an amended recommendation to approve the tariff sheets. Staff reviewed the tariff filing and found it to be in compliance with the Commission's order. After reviewing the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that Timber Creek's tariff sheets comply with the Commission's order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity, and will approve them.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Timber Creek Sewer Company's Tariff No. YS-2020-0057, as substituted, is approved to become effective on November 13, 2019. The approved tariff sheets are:
