## ORDER CANCELING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Issue Date: August 22, 2005 Effective Date: September 1, 2005

On August 9, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority. Staff requested that the Commission cancel Telephone Company of Central Florida, Inc.'s interexchange certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff. The Commission granted that certificate in Case No. TA-98-302.

Staff stated that TCCF should no longer have its interexchange certificate and tariff because the Missouri Secretary of State revoked TCCF's authority to conduct business in Missouri. Also, Staff stated that TCCF has filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection. Further, Staff stated that to Staff's knowledge, TCCF is no longer providing telecommunications service in Missouri. TCCF also requested that the Commission cancel its certificate and tariff. TCCF owes no assessment.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.081(15) states that parties have 10 days to respond to motions. TCCF failed to respond to Staff's motion within 10 days.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission

has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel TCCF's interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority is granted.
- 2. That the interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority granted to Telephone Company of Central Florida in Case No. TA-98-302 is canceled.
  - 3. That the accompanying interexchange tariff, P.S.C. MO. No. 1, is canceled.
  - 4. That this order shall become effective on September 1, 2005.
  - 5. That this case may be closed on September 2, 2005.
