ORDER REGARDING APPROVAL OF TARIFF AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

Issue Date: November 17, 2016 Effective Date: December 1, 2016

On September 30, 2016¹, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") submitted a letter and tariff designed to continue its renewable energy standard rate adjustment mechanism ("RESRAM") pursuant to Section 393.1030, RSMo Supp. 2013, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(6). The Commission denominated that tariff as Tariff No. JE-2017-0049. That tariff bore an effective date of December 1.

On November 8, after discussions with the Commission's Staff ("Staff"), GMO withdrew Tariff No. JE-2017-0049, and filed the currently pending tariff. The Commission denominated that tariff as Tariff No. YE-2017-0067. That tariff bears an effective date of December 8.

Tariff No. YE-2017-0067 would yield RESRAM revenue of approximately \$7.4 million, down from the approximately \$7.582 million that Tariff No. JE-2017-0049 would yield. GMO also submitted a Motion for Expedited Treatment of Tariff, requesting that the tariff be permitted to go into effect on December 1, 2016.

The Commission's Staff filed its recommendation on November 9. recommends that the Commission approve Tariff No. YE-2017-0067. Staff also states that the case in which the Commission authorized GMO's RESRAM contemplated that GMO would change its RESRAM charges effective December 1, 2016. Thus, Staff believes the Commission has good cause to approve the tariff on less than thirty days' notice. Staff supports GMO's motion for expedited treatment. No parties have objected to Staff's recommendation.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet conforms to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(6). Because no party has objected to the motion for expedited treatment and no detriment to GMO's customers will result from making the tariff effective on December 1, the Commission will grant the motion. The Commission concludes that the proposed tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on December 1.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Expedited Treatment of Tariff is granted.
- 2. The proposed tariff sheet filed on November 8, 2016 by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, assigned Tariff No. YE-2016-0067 and bearing an effective date of December 8, 2016, is approved to be effective on December 1, 2016. The tariff sheet approved is:
