ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DEADLINES, DIRECTING FILINGS, CONSOLIDATING CASES, AND SUSPENDING TARIFFS

On September 9, 2022, Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed a petition to change its water and sewer infrastructure rate adjustments (WSIRAs) under Sections 393.1500-1509, RSMo. MAWC also asked the Commission to approve its tariff sheets to implement the WISRAs. The tariff sheets bear an effective date of October 9, 2022.

MAWC states the proposed water rate schedule, on an annualized basis, will produce WSIRA revenues of \$13,645,968, or an increase of 4.1 percent based on the base water revenue level approved by the Commission in MAWC's most recently completed general rate proceeding. The WSIRA proposal includes an adjustment of \$930,131 to reflect an under-collection of previously authorized WSIRA water revenues. MAWC also states that the proposed sewer rate schedule, on an annualized basis, will produce WSIRA revenues of \$72,905, or an increase of 0.6 percent based on the base sewer revenue level approved by the Commission in its most recently completed general rate proceeding. The WSIRA proposal includes an adjustment of (\$3,298) to reflect an over-collection from previously authorized WSIRA sewer revenues.

Section 393.1509, RSMo, requires a Commission order regarding the WISRAs become effective no later than 180 days after the petition was filed - March 8, 2023. Additionally, Section 393.1509, RSMo, requires the Commission publish notice of the filings. Therefore, the Commission will give notice of this petition and set other procedural deadlines.

Section 393.1509, RSMo, allows the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to examine the petition and submit a report of its examination no later than 90 days after the petition was filed. Consequently, the Commission will establish a deadline for Staff to file a report and recommendation. Additionally, the Commission will set a date within the same 90-day time frame for the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) and any other parties to file objections, recommendations, or requests for hearing. The Commission will also set a time for responses to any of those filings.

Concurrently with the petition, MAWC filed revised tariff sheets to implement the WSIRAs. In order for Staff to have adequate time to perform its review and so that the Commission has adequate time to consider the petition, the tariff sheets will be suspended.

On September 9, 2022, MAWC filed motions in both cases asking that the two cases be consolidated. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) permits the consolidation of pending actions that involve related questions of law or fact. Since the cases will involve common facts, parties, and issues, the Commission will consolidate these cases.

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THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. File Nos. WO-2023-0008 and SO-2023-0009 are hereby consolidated, with File No. WO-2023-0008 being the lead case.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall serve this order on the county commission, or equivalent governmental body, of all of the counties within, MAWC's water and sewer service areas.

3. The Commission's Data Center shall also provide a copy of this order to the parties in MAWC's current general rate case, File No. WR-2022-0303.

4. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the media serving MAWC's water and sewer service areas and to the members of the General Assembly representing those service areas.

5. Any entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to do so no later than October 7, 2022.

6. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than December 8, 2022.

7. Public Counsel and any other party shall file any objections, recommendations, or hearing requests no later than December 8, 2022.

8. MAWC shall respond to Staff's recommendation or any other objections or recommendations no later than December 15, 2022.

9. Any other party wishing to respond or object to Staff's recommendation or other objections or recommendations shall do so no later than December 15, 2022.

10. The tariff sheets filed by MAWC on September 9, 2022, and assigned tariff tracking numbers YW-2023-0052 and YS-2023-0053, are suspended until March 8, 2023.

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11. This order shall be effective when issued.
