Dear Mr. Woodruff:

The accompanying tariff sheet issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or the "Company") is being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

This tariff sheet is being issued March 16, 2021 to become effective on and after April 1, 2021.

The revised sheet includes changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment ("PGA") Rider as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect an adjustment to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment ("RPGA") factor.

The change in the Total PGA rate applicable to the Company's service areas will increase to 46.02 ¢/Ccf from 37.63 ¢/Ccf for firm sales customers. The interruptible sales customers' PGA will increase to 29.37 ¢/Ccf from 27.40 ¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00 ¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. Certain workpapers have been designated "Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. 20 CSR 4240-2.135(2)(A)4. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.

Because the revised PGA will increase annual revenues in excess of 7%, the Company is also filing information pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-10.060(1): (A) a list of all cities and counties within the Company's gas certificate area which implies a business license tax on the Company's gross receipts, along with the contact information for the official responsible for administration of the tax; with (B) the reasonable estimate of the resulting annual increase in the Company's annual

gross receipts in each affected city and county; and (C) an explanation of the methods used to develop those estimates.
