# ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

Issue Date: December 30, 2022 Effective Date: January 9, 2023

On November 21, 2022,<sup>1</sup> the Commission issued its *Report and Order* ("November 21 Order") in Evergy's general rate cases, File No. ER-2022-0129 for Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro (EMM) and File No. ER-2022-0130 for Evergy Missouri West, Inc. (EMW, together with EMM as "Evergy").

EMM and EMW submitted compliance tariffs on December 2. EMM submitted tariffs assigned Tracking Nos. YE-2023-0103 and YE-2023-0104. EMW submitted tariffs assigned Tracking No. YE-2023-0105. All tariffs had a 30-day proposed effective date of January 1, 2023. The Commission ordered its Staff (Staff) to provide a recommendation regarding the tariffs, and set a time for other parties to also respond.

The Commission's *Amended Report and Order*, issued on December 8 (Amended Order) supplanted the November 21 Order.<sup>2</sup> Subsequently, EMM and EMW filed various substitute tariff sheets on December 15, December 18, December 20, December 21,

December 22, December 23, and December 27. Evergy voluntarily extended the proposed effective date of the tariffs to January 10, 2023.

On December 27, Staff recommended approval of the tariffs. Staff stated that its review confirms the tariffs are in compliance with the Amended Order, as well as with the four previously approved stipulations and agreements. The Office of Public Counsel also responded on December 27, stating that its specific concerns were addressed in the December 27 filed substitute tariff sheets. Public Counsel did not offer any further argument that the substituted tariffs are not in compliance with the Amended Order. However, Public Counsel did ask the Commission to issue a decision on its still pending reconsideration request prior to the effective date of the compliance tariffs, as that decision may materially alter the revenue requirement, and thus require new substitute tariffs. The Commission will address the reconsideration motion in a separate order.

Due to the numerous and recent substitutions as well as the number of issues involved in the underlying case, the Commission on its own motion set an additional time for further responses. No responses were received.

On December 28, Evergy filed its *Motion for Agenda Session to Approve Compliance Tariffs*. Among other requests, that pleading requested the earliest possible effective date. In explanation, Evergy states its extension of the effective date by 10 days was intended to give the Commission additional time to issue a ten-day tariff approval order. As the last business day that would have a 10-day notice period is today, Friday, December 30, Evergy posits that the effective date could be moved forward to

January 9, 2023, and still provide a 10-day notice period. Evergy states that time is of the essence. The Commission agrees and finds the request reasonable.

Upon reviewing the pleadings, the Commission finds Evergy's proposed tariffs, assigned Tracking Nos. YE-2023-0103, YE-2023-0104, and YE-2023-0105, all as substituted, comply with the Commission's Amended Order and four previously approved stipulations and agreements and will approve them. To accommodate Evergy's chosen tariff effective date, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days to match the effective date of the tariffs and approve the tariffs to become effective on January 9, 2023.

# THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The proposed tariff sheets filed on December 2, 2022, and assigned Tracking Nos. YE-2023-0103, YE-2023-0104, and YE-2023-0105, all as substituted, are approved, to become effective on January 9, 2023.
- 2. By the action taken in this order, Evergy's request for an Agenda Session to approve its compliance tariffs is moot.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on January 9, 2023.
