The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued October 18, 2018 to become effective on and after November 1, 2018.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect an adjustment to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) factor.

The change in the PGA factor applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will decrease to 46.00¢/Ccf from 48.00¢/Ccf for firm sales customers. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase to 31.87¢/Ccf from 27.30¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will decrease the firm sales customers' PGA factor to 65.00¢/Ccf from 67.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will increase to 33.12¢/Ccf from 28.55¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing, which are being provided to the Staff. Certain workpapers have been designated "Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its

gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
