MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company") and, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.160, submits its Motion for Expedited Treatment and states as follows:

1. Concurrent with filing this pleading, Ameren Missouri is also filing a new tariff to add its new Home Energy Performance (HEP) Pilot to the Company's portfolio of natural gas energy efficiency programs. The new program will be run jointly with the Company's residential electric energy efficiency program with the same name. The tariff is targeted to homes where Ameren Missouri provides both electric and natural gas service. The HEP pilot was first approved as a joint utility approach in the Company's MEEIA tariff filing

2. Ameren Missouri is also filing revised tariff sheets which relaxes one of the qualification requirements for the Company's ceiling insulation tariff. The current requirement is that the customer must have an existing ceiling insulation of R11 or less. The revision to this proposed tariff will change the requirement from R11 to R19. The change to R19 will allow more customers the opportunity to participate.

3. Ameren Missouri requests these revised tariff sheets be approved so they are effective on March 1, 2013, so that the natural gas portion of the HEP pilot will be

available to customers at the same time as Ameren Missouri launches the electric portion of the program.¹

4. Ameren Missouri has filed this request for expedited treatment as soon as possible after deciding the change was necessary and after discussing this matter with the Energy Efficiency Advisory Group. There will be no negative effect on the party's customers or the general public in granting this expedited treatment request.

5. Ameren Missouri has discussed these tariffs with the Missouri Public Service Commission Staff, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Office of the Public Counsel. Counsel for each has authorized Ameren Missouri to represent to the Missouri Public Service Commission that they do not object to this request for expedited treatment.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests the Commission issue an order approving the revised tariffs so that they are effective no later than March 1, 2013.
