





9.3 Movement of Exchanges Between Rate Groups

- 9.3.1 The term "Rate Group," as used herein, refers to Access Line Limits
- 9.3.2 An exchange is placed in a Rate Group on the basis of the number of central office access lines in that exchange. Access lines, included for this purpose, consist of all lines connected with classes of service found in Section 9 of this tariff and Payphone Line Service, Mobile Telephone Units, Centrex lines and the open end of Foreign Exchange Terminals.
- 9.3.3 When the number of access lines, as described in Section 9.3.2 above, in a local calling area increases or decreases by growth or loss of access lines so that the number of access lines exceeds or falls below the Access Line Limits by as many as ten (10) access lines for the Rate Group in which the exchange is placed, and such count continues for four (4) consecutive months, then the exchange thus affected will be moved to the appropriate Rate Group after compliance with the procedures set forth in Section 9.3.4 following.
- 9.3.4 When an exchange is to be moved from one Rate Group to another in accordance with the circumstances stated in Section 9.3.3 above, the change will be effected by:
 - A. Notice of the change by personal or written notice to city officials and to officers of Chambers of Commerce or other similar organizations of the community involved. Existing Customers will be notified by Bill Inserts.
 - B. Notice of the change by letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission, explaining the changes to be made, together with an attachment showing complete information as to the exchange affected and revised tariff sheets.
 - C. New local service rates as set forth in the revised tariff sheets referred to in Section 9.3.4.B above will be made effective when the tariff becomes effective by the Missouri Public Service Commission.


9.9 Discontinuance of EAS



- 9.9.1 The Company will discontinue service from specific EAS routes between exchanges as a result of a survey as set forth following:
 - A. Company has received petition or petitions representing at least 20% of the customers from one of the affected exchanges or at least 10% of the customers in each of the affected exchanges, requesting that the Company conduct a survey to determine whether EAS should be discontinued.


If prior surveys have been conducted in the affected exchanges, at least two years shall have elapsed since the last survey before an additional survey is initiated.

- B. A minimum of 50% of the combined total customers in the affected exchanges must vote. Then, at least two thirds (66 2/3%) of the combined total customers in the affected exchanges voting, must vote to discontinue such service.
- C. The survey cards will be returned by the customers to the Secretary of the Public Service Commission for validation and tabulation. The Public Service Commission will advise the Company of the survey results and, if the appropriate requirements are met, the Company will then discontinue such service, together with the appropriate EAS Rate Component, as soon as is practicable.


B. Extended Area Service (EAS) Considerations




9.26.4 Regulations

- A. Unless specified in these regulations, MCA is offered to all classes and grades of residence and business customers located in an MCA exchange.
- B. Optional MCA Service is not offered in conjunction with Payphone Line Service or Cellular Service.
- C. Optional MCA is designed and intended for the exclusive use of the end user customers of the Telephone Company. Optional MCA is not to be shared, resold or used in any configuration of customer provided equipment with the intent of reselling the service. With the exception of Shared Tenant Service, as described in other tariffs of the Telephone Company, Optional MCA is available to interexchange carriers or other telecommunications service providers for administrative trunks only.
- D. In situations where multiple access lines share the same working telephone number, if one such line subscribes to MCA service, then all lines must subscribe to MCA service.
- E. In situations where a hunting arrangement between access lines is provided by the Telephone Company, no MCA line may be configured to hunt to a non-MCA line.
- F. The minimum service period for subscription to Optional MCA Service is one month.
- G. Rate Application
 - 1. The MCA monthly rates specified in 9.26.5, below, apply on a per line basis.
 - 2. The MCA monthly rates are billed one month in advance.
 - 3. Optional MCA rates and charges apply in addition to all other rates and charges paid by the customer for other services of the Telephone Company.

11.1 Individual Case Basis Arrangements

Rates for Dedicated Access, Private Line, Centrex Service and CO Based Virtual PBX Custom (Plexar-Custom*) services will be determined on an Individual Case Basis (ICB). ICB rates will be structured to recover the Company's cost of providing the services and will be made available to Customers in a nondiscriminatory manner. Terms of the specific ICB contracts will be made available to the Missouri Public Service Commission upon a request on a proprietary basis. ICB rates will not be used for switched services.

11.2 Customer Requested Service Suspensions

At the request of the Customer the Company will suspend incoming and outgoing service on the Customer's access line for a period of time not to exceed one year. The equipment is left in place and directory listings are continued during the suspension period without change. At the Customer's request the Company will, for 30 days, provide the Customer with an intercept recording referring callers to another number. This service is available to Customers at no charge.

The Company will assess a lower monthly rate for Customer Requested Service Suspension as noted below. However, any mileage charges, monthly cable charges or monthly construction charges are still due, without reduction, during the period of suspension.
