ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF

Issue Date: April 19, 2007

Effective Date: April 29, 2007

On March 30, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificates of service authority granted to Qwest Interprise America, Inc. Staff states that Qwest was granted certificates of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange in Case No. TA-97-207. In that same case, the Commission approved the company's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1. Subsequently, the Commission granted a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service to the company in Case No. TA-2002-119.

Staff further states that the company has requested that its certificates of service authority be canceled as it is not providing any services in Missouri and has no customers. Staff finally states that the company has no past due annual reports or assessment and that no complaints have been filed against the company since the Commission began its Electronic Filing and Information System.

Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion and Qwest has not responded.

Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission will therefore cancel the certificates of service authority granted to Qwest in Case Nos. TA-97-207 and TA-2002-119.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificates of service authority to provide interexchange, non-switched local and private pay telephone service granted to Qwest Interprise America, Inc. in Case Nos. TA-97-207 and TA-2002-119 are canceled.

2. The tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, approved for Qwest Interprise America, Inc. is canceled.

3. This order shall become effective on April 29, 2007.

4. This case shall be closed on April 30, 2007.
