ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE

Issue Date: December 22, 2014

Effective Date: January 1, 2015

On December 1, 2014, Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. asked the Commission to recognize its name change from Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Communications Network Services, to Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Communications. The company also filed a revised tariff to be effective January 1, 2015.

In response, the Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation regarding that request by December 19, later extended to December 22. Staff's recommendation, filed on December 22, advises the Commission that the notice of name change and the revised tariff comply with the Commission's requirements for a name change. Staff recommends the Commission recognize the name change and either approve the tariff or allow it to go into effect. No one opposes the name change.

The Commission has reviewed the notice of name change and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the name change should be recognized.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission recognizes the change of name of Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Communications Network Services, to Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Communications.

2. The revised tariff filed by Consolidated Communications Enterprise Services, Inc. d/b/a Consolidated Communications is approved to be effective on January 1, 2015. The tariff approved is:
