ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE AND APPROVING TARIFF SHEETS

On December 15, 2006, The Pager Company, d/b/a The Pager & Phone Company, filed adoption notices and revised tariff sheets to reflect its change of corporate name to YourTel America, Inc. The tariff sheets have a proposed effective date of January 17, 2007.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a verified recommendation on December 29, 2006. Staff recommends that the Commission recognize the new name. Staff states that the company's application clearly sets out the old name and new name, includes evidence of registration of the name change with the Missouri Secretary of State, and includes an adoption notice and revised title sheet for each of the referenced tariffs.

The Commission has reviewed the application and Staff's recommendation, which are hereby admitted into evidence. The Commission finds that The Pager Company, d/b/a The Pager & Phone Company's name change to YourTel America, Inc., shall be recognized and the proposed tariff sheets shall be approved.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The change of corporate name of The Pager Company, d/b/a The Pager & Phone Company, to YourTel America, Inc., is recognized.

2. The tariff sheets filed on December 15, 2006, Tariff File Nos. YC-2007-0418 and YC-2007-0419, are approved for service on and after January 17, 2007. The tariff sheets approved are:
