ANNOUNCEMENT DISTRIBUTION SERVICES

1.1 GENERAL

- 1.1.1 Announcement Distribution Services enable customers to provide specific information to the general public.

Announcement Distribution Services accessible by the general public will hereafter be referred to as Public Announcement Distribution Services. Examples of such service include Time and Temperature, Weather and Dial-A-(_____).

- 1.1.2 Announcement Equipment

In compliance with the Federal Communication Commission Computer Inquiry II decision, Docket No. 20828 adopted October 7, 1981, and released October 30, 1981, the Announcement Services using Telephone Company-provided equipment located in a Telephone Company central office was discontinued effective January 1, 1983. Therefore, those customers who were served by Telephone Company-provided announcement equipment located in a Telephone Company central office have disconnected such service and have secured announcement equipment from another supplier and arranged for announcement distribution services from the Telephone Company.

- 1.1.3 In addition to rates and charges, following, for Announcement Distribution Services, Service and Equipment Charges as specified in the Local Exchange Tariff are applicable.

1.2 DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

1.2.1 Public Announcement Distribution Service provides facilities to enable completion of Public Announcement Distribution Service calls. Following are the types of distribution methods offered:

A. Facilities Delivery

Facilities Delivery provides announcement facilities and, when required, network traffic load protection for customers whose announcement equipment requires individual access line termination. Public Announcement Distribution Service calls are delivered to the customer-premises announcement equipment. Charges for such service are as specified in Paragraph 1.4.1, following.

B. Dedicated Subcenter Distribution Network

The Dedicated Subcenter Distribution Network provides facilities and inherent network traffic load protection for customers whose announcement equipment provides a continuous announcement to the Telephone Company Subcenter Network. Public Announcement Distribution Service calls are delivered to the Telephone Company subcenter. This distribution method is obsolete to existing customers at existing locations. Charges for such service are as specified in Paragraph 1.4.2, following.

1.3 PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT DISTRIBUTION SERVICE - REGULATIONS

1.3.1 The Telephone Company will furnish, where facilities are available, all facilities to customers for their use in providing prerecorded public announcements under the following conditions:

A. In order to assure satisfactory service to parties calling prerecorded announcements and to protect the telecommunications network for use of the general public, Public Announcement Distribution Service customers are required to subscribe to facilities sufficient to prevent a call overflow exceeding 5 percent in more than 40 days of a continuous 12-month period and sufficient to prevent call overflow exceeding 15 percent in more than 15 days of a continuous 12-month period.

- B. Upon applying for service, the customer may be required to designate the nature of the prerecorded announcement for which the distribution facilities are to be used (e.g., news, sports, inspirational messages, weather, time and temperature, etc.). In addition, the customer may be required to provide expected call volumes and announcement duration based on reliable market research or analysis which can be reviewed by the Telephone Company. Once service has been established, the customer must give advance notice to the Telephone Company of any change to be made in the kind of announcement provided over Telephone Company facilities and must supply new calling volumes and announcement duration data to allow the Telephone Company to determine if a change in the number of facilities to accommodate the new announcement will be required.
- C. The furnishing of facilities for Public Announcement Distribution Service contemplates that the customer's use of such facilities will be such that the call volumes received at any time will not cause impairment, disruption or deterioration of the quality of other exchange telephone service or Long Distance Message Telecommunications Service furnished by the Telephone Company for use by its customers. In the event that the use of a Public Announcement Distribution Service causes such impairment, disruption or deterioration, as described more particularly in 1.3.1, A., preceding, the following options are available to customers:
1. Subscribe to additional access lines to continue to maintain an acceptable level of service as described in 1.3.1, A., preceding, or
 2. The addition of network traffic load protection which makes it unnecessary to provide additional access lines to handle abnormal call volumes.

In the event of the Public Announcement Distribution Service customer's refusal to subscribe to the options described above, the Telephone Company shall have the right to discontinue such service without prior notification to the customer.

- D. The Public Announcement Distribution Service customer indemnifies and saves the Telephone Company harmless against claims for libel, slander or infringement of copyright arising from the material transmitted over facilities furnished hereunder and against all other claims arising out of any act or mission of the customer in connection with facilities provided by the Telephone Company.
- E. The customer assumes all risk for damages arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or defects in transmission, failures or defects in equipment and facilities furnished by the Telephone Company occurring in the course of furnishing telephone service or other communication services furnished him by the Telephone Company except as follows: If service is interrupted other than by negligence or willful act of the customer, an allowance at the rate for that portion of the customer's service affected by the interruption shall be made for the time such interruption continues after the fact is reported by the customer or after detected by the Telephone Company, and the interruption is for more than 24 hours.
