BASE RATE AREA MAP

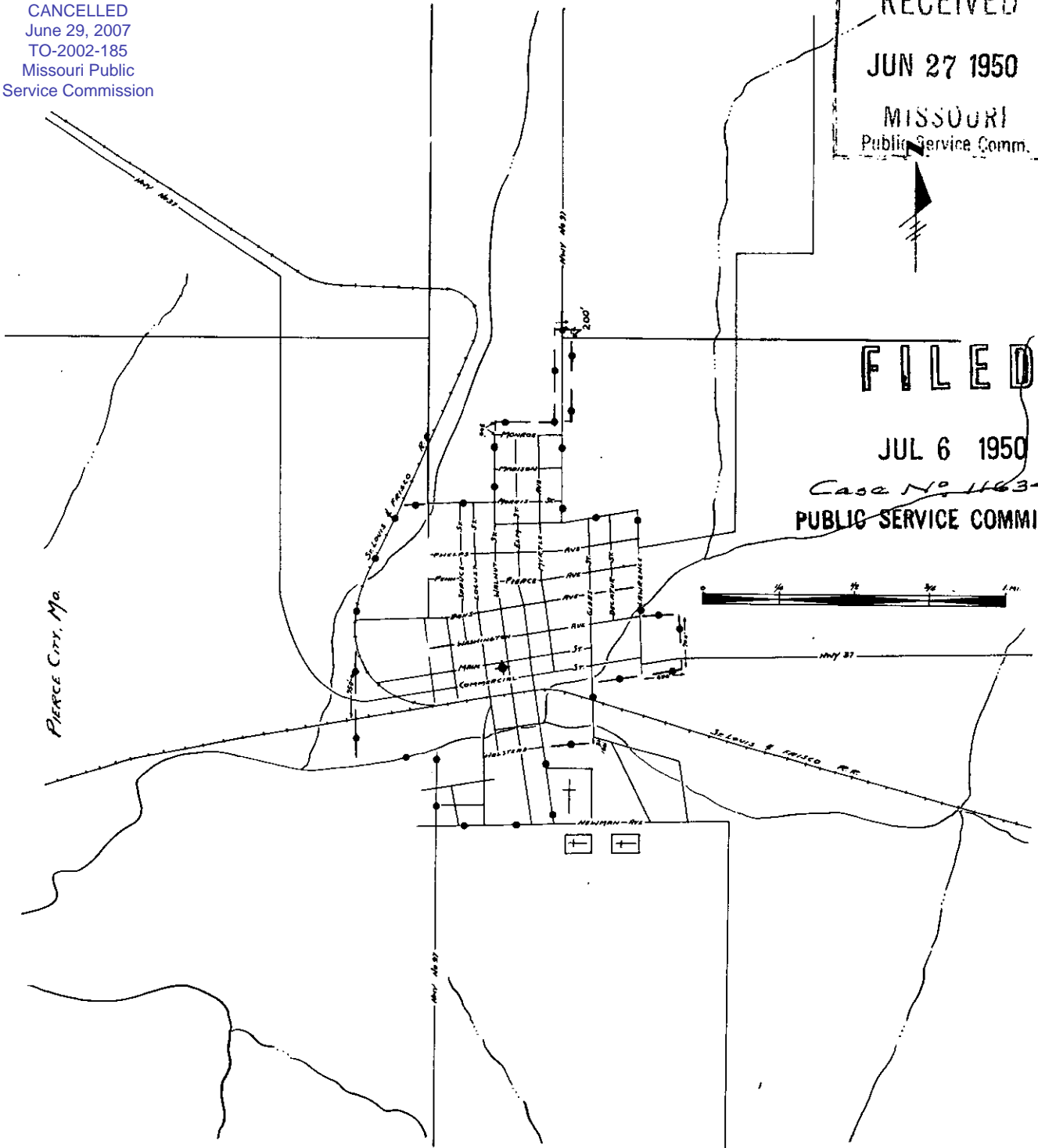

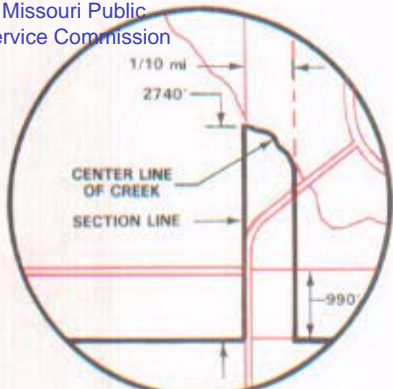

P. S. C. Mo. No. 17 EXCHANGE AREA MAP

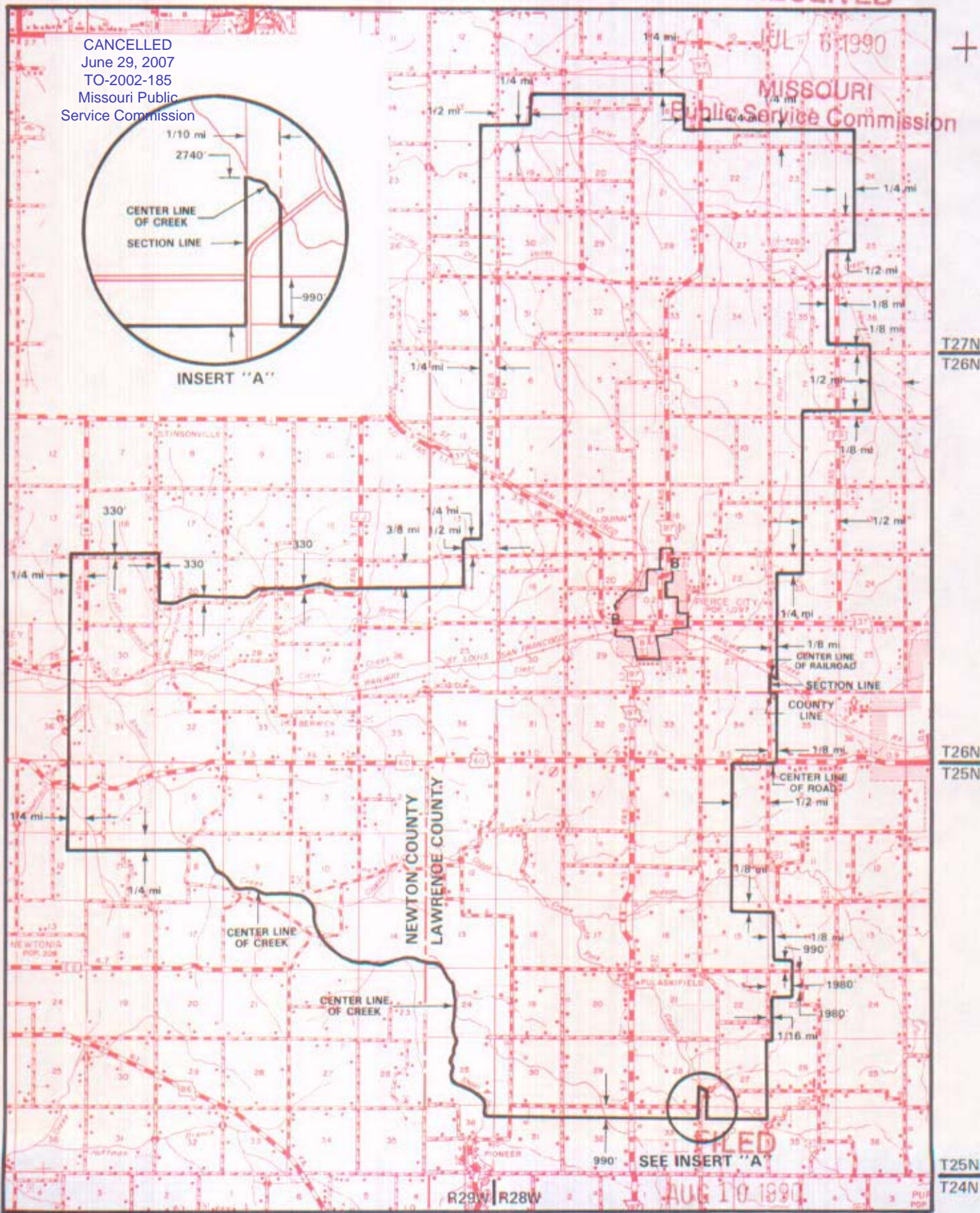
