These tariff sheets are being issued October 10, 2014 to become effective on and after November 9, 2014.

The purpose of this proposed change is to allow Multifamily Income Qualified (MFIQ) buildings that have at least 51% of units that are federally subsidized to receive low income upgrades for all units in the building, including those that are non-subsidized.

This proposed change has been discussed with the program stakeholders including Missouri Public Service Commission Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Department of Energy who have indicated no opposition to the changes proposed in this filing.
