ORDER APPROVING TARIFF REVISION

Issue Date: June 14, 2023

Effective Date: July 1, 2023

On May 1, 2023, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed tariff sheets to adjust its Demand Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) for an over-recovery in the first year of Liberty's Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act Cycle 1. Those tariff sheets bear an effective date of July 1, 2023.

The proposed change will decrease residential customers' DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00087 to \$0.00051 per kWh. For a typical residential customer using 1,046 kWh, this would result in a decrease of \$0.38 per month. The proposed change will also decrease the DSIM Rider rate for small commercial and industrial (Small C & I), and large commercial and industrial (Large C&I) customers. For a Small C&I customer with typical use of 1,430 kWh per month, this would result in a billing decrease of \$0.93 per month. For a typical Large C & I customer using 38,679 kWh monthly, the billing decrease result would be \$25.14 per month.

The Commission ordered its Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation about the tariff sheets and set a deadline for responses. Staff filed a recommendation to approve the tariff sheets. No other responses were received.

The Commission reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation, and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved. The Commission will approve Liberty's tariff sheets to become effective on July 1, 2023. In addition, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days so that the order will be effective concurrently with the tariff sheets.
