Enclosed herewith for filing with the Missouri Public Service Commission are the revised tariff sheet, P.S.C. MO. No. 7 First Revised Sheet No. R-28 and revised sheet, P.S.C. MO. No. 8 First Revised Sheet No. R-28 in regards to the Eastern and Western Missouri operating divisions of Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire (the "Company"). These revised tariff sheets, have an issue date of February 5, 2020, and an effective date of March 6, 2020, reflected by the Company's tariffs.

In order to better serve the low-income customers that reside in our service territory throughout the state, we are submitting these revised tariffs for your approval. Your approval will allow the Community Action Agency's (CAA) that we provide funding to flexibility to utilize our funds to address homes that have previously gone through the weatherization program (currently, any home weatherized after 9/30/1994, the CAA's cannot assist them with any further weatherization needs that may have arisen). It will also allow the CAA's the ability to utilize a portion of our funding towards hazardous and health and safety concerns of the home.

The Company will provide guidance to the CAA's on how the funds are to be used and what would and would not qualify as an authorized replacement/repair at the home. The Company will track all measures installed along with repairs made to the home and will provide a report to the commission on a quarterly basis.

The funds for the replacement/repairs to the home will come out of the Company's current tariff amount (\$950,000 for the eastern service area, and \$750,000 for the western service area) and will be part of each CAA's current funding allocation. No additional funds are being requested to operate this revision to the Company's tariff.
