ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

Issue Date: August 10, 2011 Effective Date: August 12, 2011

On April 27, 2011, the Commission granted the Joint Applications of Missouri-American Water Company and Roark Water & Sewer, Inc. to allow Missouri-American to acquire and operate the water and sewer systems previously owned and operated by Roark. That order required Missouri-American to notify the Commission upon the transfer of the assets and to file tariffs adopting Roark's operating tariffs. On August 2, Missouri-American filed notice indicating that the transfer of assets was completed on July 29. At the same time, Missouri-American filed water and sewer tariffs adopting Roark's tariffs as its own.

Missouri-American's revised tariffs carry an effective date of September 1, but Missouri-American asked the Commission to expedite its approval of those tariffs to allow them to go into effect on August 12. Before acting on Missouri-American's request, the Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation indicating whether the Commission should approve the submitted tariffs.

Staff filed its recommendation on August 10, indicating that Missouri-American's water and sewer tariff filings, as revised in a filing made on August 8, comply with the Commission's order. Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariffs.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariffs submitted by Missouri-American comply with the Commission's order approving the transfer of assets to Missouri-American. The Commission further finds that Missouri-American has established good cause to approve its tariffs on an expedited basis.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Expedited Treatment filed by Missouri-American Water Company on August 2, 2011, is granted.
- 2. The tariff sheets issued on August 2, 2011, by Missouri-American Water Company, assigned tariff tracking numbers YS-2012-0051 and YW-2012-0052, are approved, as substituted, to become effective on August 12, 2011. The tariff sheets approved are:
