Atmos Energy Corporation herewith submits for filing the 4th Revised Sheet No. 44 for all areas of Missouri which replaces the 3rd Revised Sheet No. 44.

This filing reflects an increase in rates for all the areas of Missouri except the Southeastern Area and the West Area (Old Greeley). As a result of this filing a typical residential customer in the West Area (Old Butler) will experience an increase of approximately 17%; in the West Area (Old Greeley) a decrease of approximately 24%, in the Southeastern Area (Old SEMO) a decrease of approximately 1%; in the Southeastern Area (Old Neelyville) an increase of approximately 3%, in the Kirksville Area an increase of approximately 6%, and in the Northeastern Area an increase of approximately 12% during this winter season.

Your review and approval of these sheets to become effective November 1, 2008 are respectfully requested.
