Community Solar Pilot Program - Case No. ET-2020-0259**

Dear Judge Woodruff:

On April 17, 2020, The Empire District Electric Company (“Liberty”) filed an application for approval of a Community Solar Pilot Program, along with proposed tariff sheets. Since the initial filing of the Community Solar Pilot Program application and tariff sheets, Liberty continued to work with Staff on program design and costs. Also, in the interim, the complete tariff book was replaced to reflect the addition of the fictitious name “Liberty” for The Empire District Electric Company (moving from PSC MO No. 5 to PSC MO No. 6).

Given the foregoing, the Community Solar Pilot Program tariff sheets filed on April 17, 2020, were withdrawn, and new Community Solar Pilot Program tariff sheets were submitted on September 15, 2020. Those tariff sheets were approved by the Commission and took effect on October 15, 2020.

An error was discovered in the final, approved tariff sheets now in effect. In the process of making edits between the initial filing and the final submission, a section of text was accidentally deleted. The missing paragraphs are specific to the billing process for the GP, TEB, and LP classes. To address the error, the following sheets are being submitted:

PSC MO No. 6, Section 4, 1st Revised Sheet No. 25g;
PSC MO No. 6, Section 4, 1st Revised Sheet No. 25h;
PSC MO No. 6, Section 4, 1st Revised Sheet No. 25i;
PSC MO No. 6, Section 4, 1st Revised Sheet No. 25j;
PSC MO No. 6, Section 4, Original Sheet No. 25k.

These sheets bear an issue date of October 16, 2020, and a proposed effective date of November 15, 2020. A redlined version was previously provided to Staff and OPC and is attached hereto.
