The tariff sheets listed below issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued May 17, 2018 to become effective on and after June 1, 2018.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect an adjustment to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) factor.

The change in the PGA factor applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will decrease from 56.00¢/Ccf to 48.00¢/Ccf for firm sales customers. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 32.69¢/Ccf to 27.30¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will decrease the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 76.00¢/Ccf to 67.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will decrease from 33.94¢/Ccf to 28.55¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

We are enclosing workpapers supporting this filing with the copy of this filing being provided to the Staff. Certain pages of the workpapers have been designated "Confidential" since they contain market specific information directly relating to the natural gas markets where Ameren Missouri must compete for its gas supplies. The Company requests that these papers be handled in a manner consistent with this designation.
