This feature allows an end-user to request an automatic trace of the incoming call. This provides an easy way to trace obscene, threatening, or harassing calls. After hanging up on a nuisance call, a user can invoke Customer Originated Trace by going off-hook, receiving dial tone, and then dialing the Customer Originated Trace access code \*57 on Touch Tone phone (1157 rotary dial).

If the incoming line history block contains valid information about the last calling party, the user receives a confirmation announcement including instructions on following up on the trace request. If a call is traced that has been traced before, the user still receives the confirmation announcement. The customer using the feature would be required to contact the local authorities or police for further action. The customer is not provided the traced number. The results of a successful trace will only be provided to legal authorities with proper authorization.

If the customer makes or receives another call before activating the trace, or if the Call Waiting feature is activated prior to activating the trace, the Customer Originated Trace Feature will not record the correct number.

Customer Originated Trace will trace only those calls which are originated from a location served by the CLASS network. A per activation charge applies to each successful activation of this feature.

6. Selective Distinctive Alert

This feature allows residential and business users to pre-select which calls receive distinctive alerting treatment based on the telephone number of the calling party ( up to 10 calling directory numbers). Distinctive Ringing is limited to four Distinctive Ringing/Call Waiting tone patterns per line. To access this feature, a user picks up the telephone and dials the Selective Distinctive Alert access code \*61 from a Touch Tone phone (1161 rotary dial) and follows the recorded instructions. If the user is not assigned the feature or cannot access the feature, the user receives reorder or the local exchange carrier standard announcement indicating that the feature cannot be accessed.

If the user is not assigned the feature or cannot access the feature, the user receives reorder or a telephone company standard announcement indicating that the feature cannot be accessed.

8. Selective Call Forwarding

This feature allows users to pre-select calls that will forward based on the telephone number of the calling party (up to 10 directory numbers). To access this feature, a user picks up the telephone and dials the Selective Call Forwarding access code \*63 from a Touch Tone phone (1163 rotary dial) and follows the recorded instructions. If the user is not assigned the feature or cannot access the feature, the user receives reorder or a telephone company standard announcement indicating that the feature cannot be accessed.

If the Selective Call Forwarding feature is off, an announcement informs the user to press "3" to turn the feature on. If the user chooses to edit the screening list, the user can add, remove or review the entries currently on the list through interactive announcements.

Unidentified Call Rejection automatically blocks any unidentified calls without ever ringing at the called parties telephone number. The user can deactivate this feature by dialing the access code \*87 from a Touch Tone phone (1187 rotary dial). The calling party will receive a recorded announcement, the called party does not accept unidentified calls and suggests the calling party unblock delivery of the callers telephone and redial.

B. General Regulations

1. CLASS features can be provided on a stand alone basis or may be enhanced by use with Custom Calling Service features (Section 4, Sheets 6 - 7).
2. CLASS features are provided from specially equipped Telephone Company Central Offices and enable customers to access various features by dialing specific codes on either a rotary dial or Touch Tone calling basis.
3. The customer of record will be responsible for all rates and charges associated with the CLASS features as described in Rates and Charges. The customer of record will be charged for all features activated on his/her service and charged the applicable monthly subscription rate for each line on which a CLASS feature is provided.
4. CLASS features are available to customers who have rotary or Touch Tone service for calls within the CLASS Calling Service area. Customers with rotary service can access CLASS features by dialing "11" instead of "\*".

- a. private, nonprofit, tax-exempt, domestic violence enforcement agencies
- b. federal, state and local law enforcement agencies

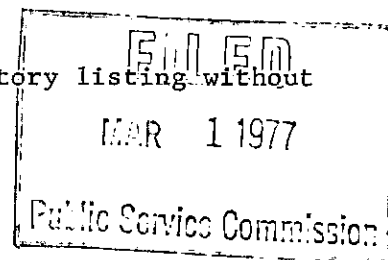

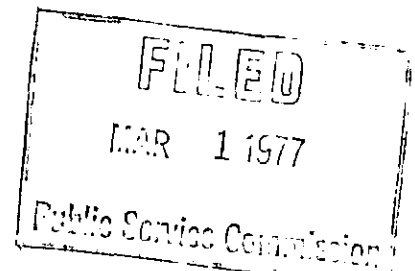
