**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: May 3, 2016

Effective Date: May 25, 2016

On March 24, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff and supporting testimony to revise its Energy Efficiency Investment Charge (EEIC) Rider. The tariff bears an effective date of May 25, 2016.

The EEIC Rider filing would increase annual rates by approximately \$37.4 million. Such an increase would result in a 1.2 percent increase in a typical residential customer's bill, which is an increase of approximately \$2.22 per month. Ameren Missouri filed this tariff to recover the cost of its Cycle 2 Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) programs, which will run from March 1, 2016, through February 28, 2019.<sup>1</sup>

As required by Commission rule<sup>2</sup>, the Staff of the Commission filed a Recommendation. Staff agrees with Ameren Missouri's analysis, and recommends the Commission approve the tariff.

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<sup>1</sup> Ameren Missouri's Cycle 1 MEEIA programs had expired on December 31, 2015. On January 6, 2016, in File No. ER-2016-0131, the Commission approved an Ameren Missouri tariff that reduced the company's annual rates by approximately \$123 million to reflect the expiration of those programs.
