**ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE AND APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: November 1, 2007

Effective Date: November 9, 2007

On October 9, 2007, Working Assets Funding Service, Inc., d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance (WAFS), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking approval to adopt the “doing business as” name Credo Long Distance and to operate under that name in Missouri.

On October 22, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order directing WAFS to correct deficiencies in its application. WAFS updated its filing on October 22, 2007, to bring it into compliance with Commission rules.

The Commission Staff filed a recommendation on October 31, 2007, stating that it had reviewed the company's tariff and recommending that the Commission issue an order recognizing the name change and approving the tariff sheets filed to effectuate that name change with an effective date of November 9, 2007, as requested by the company.

The Commission has reviewed WAFS's tariff filing and Staff's verified recommendation, which are hereby admitted into evidence, and finds that WAFS's name change should be recognized. The Commission further finds that the tariff sheets should be approved.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Commission recognizes the adoption by Working Assets Funding Service, Inc., d/b/a Working Assets Long Distance of the fictitious name Working Assets Funding Service, Inc., d/b/a Credo Long Distance.

2. The tariff filed by Working Assets Funding Service, Inc., d/b/a Credo Long Distance, on October 10, 2007, and assigned tariff number YX-2008-0218, is approved to become effective on November 9, 2007. The tariff approved is:

3. This order shall become effective on November 9, 2007.
