Dear Mr. Woodruff:

The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 6, Schedule of Rates for Electricity:

These tariff sheets are being issued May 23, 2014 to become effective on and after July 23, 2014.

The Company is filing the Solar Rebate tariff to provide notice that solar rebate payments will discontinue when the Company has fully paid out the "specified level" of \$91.9 million as defined in the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in File Number ET-2014-0085. The Company expects to pay out all of the "specified level" sometime in 2014.

The filing also asks that the Commission find that the maximum retail rate increase, as outlined in §393.1030.3 RSMo. will be reached when the "specified level" has been paid out.

This filing does not have any impact on 1) the reservation queue developed with stakeholders as an outcome of the Stipulation and Agreement, 2) rebate commitments made by the Company to individual customers, or 3) the impact of and rules related to the June 30, 2014 deadline for customers to be eligible for a \$2.00 per watt rebate.

This proposed change has been discussed with Staff and they have indicated that the proposed language is acceptable though they have not indicated a position on the filing itself.
