The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

These tariff sheets are being issued June 16, 2017 to become effective on and after July 1, 2017.

These revised sheets include changes to Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) Clause as approved by the Commission. These revisions reflect adjustments to the Regular Purchased Gas Adjustment (RPGA) and Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factors.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's service areas, excluding the Rolla area, will increase the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 51.00¢/Ccf to 56.00¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will remain unchanged at 33.64¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA will remain unchanged at 0.00¢/Ccf.

The changes in the PGA factors applicable to the Company's Rolla system (Rolla, Salem, and Owensville) service area will increase the firm sales customers' PGA factor from 61.00 ¢/Ccf to 68.00 ¢/Ccf. The interruptible sales customers' PGA factor will remain unchanged at 34.89 ¢/Ccf. The transportation PGA factor will remain unchanged at 0.00 ¢/Ccf.
